### **Rules of the Meeting**

1. To obtain the floor, the delegate should stand, remain standing until recognized by the chair, then give their name and the State they represent.
2. The right of the floor is open to all members present at this assembly for discussion purposes: however, only authorized delegates or members of the General Board may make or second a motion and vote in this assembly. The motion and second may not be made by members of the same State Council.
3. All qualified delegates and members of the General Board will be seated in a group and clearly visible to the presiding officer.
4. All debate will be limited to five minutes on any one topic, and no one may speak twice on the same subject until all others have been recognized.
5. The Midwest Area Regional Council by-laws and Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised, shall be the parliamentary authority at the meeting.
6. The General Board shall consist of two representatives and the State President or their alternate of each member state council.

Parliamentarian
